

Championship Points

To accumulate points and be eligible for championship trophies in a class, you must be an SCCA member in good standing and complete more than half of the scheduled events for the season. For instance, if there are 10 scheduled points events, you must compete in a minimum of 6 to be eligible for championship points. Points will be awarded to all participants. However, only SCCA members will have their points tallied for the championship. If a driver competes in one or more classes and fulfills the “more than half” rule, points will be calculated in each class the driver participated in. However, the driver can only be the champion of one class; the class he/she scored the highest in.

Points will be awarded as follows.

Position	Points
1 st	10
2 nd	7
3 rd	5
4 th	4
5 th	2
On course	1

Example Class Scoring

Position	Driver	Points	Comments
1 st	A	10	SCCA Member
2 nd	B	7	Not an SCCA Member
3 rd	C	5	SCCA Member
4 th	D	4	SCCA Member
5 th	E	2	Not an SCCA Member

Only Drivers A, C, and D will receive Championship points. Those points will be reflected as:

Driver	Points
A	10
C	5
D	4

These points will accumulate throughout the season. At anytime before the first half of the season that a non SCCA Member joins SCCA, his/her prior event points will be eligible for Championship points. For example, if there are 10 events a non member must become an SCCA member prior to the 5th event. It is the new member's responsibility to coordinate with the Solo Chairman to update their status with in the ALSCCA scoring system.
