The Novice Program

One of the goals of the Alabama Region Solo Program is promote our sport. Starting with the 2009 season, ALSCCA will have a Novice Program (NP). The NP is designed to introduce new drivers to the sport of Solo/Autocross. We will focus on education. Each event will have a brief Novice class followed by a course walk. All participants in the Novice class will run in the same run group. They will have the benefit of riding along with an experienced driver prior to driving the course themselves. They will all receive instruction from experienced drivers while on course during their first run (instructors may ride along on other runs if the instructor or novice driver deems it necessary). Novices will have the benefit of one additional run beyond the scheduled runs

The Novice Program will be a seasonal event with a Novice Champion (Rookie of the Year). Below are detailed guidelines for the Novice Class.

Novice Class Rules

Beginning with the 2009 season the Alabama region of the SCCA will add a Novice Class to each event. Below is the guidance for the Novice Class.

Eligibility

- 1. Participants in the Novice Class (NC) do not have to be members of SCCA.
- 2. Participants in the NC may not have run more than 3 Solo events prior to the current season, no matter what region.

PAX

- 1. All NC participants will awarded raw and PAX times within the group.
- 2. PAX times will determine the winner of each event and Season Champion.

Classes

- 1. NC participants will class their vehicle in accordance (IAW) with SCCA rules.
- 2. Car numbers will be assigned (IAW) ALSCCA practices with the addition of the letter "N" at the beginning of the class. (i.e. NES 14).

Season Winner

1. Season Points will be determined by points awarded throughout the season, following the current guidelines and rules that govern ALSCCA Solo Classes.

The Novice Champion (Rookie of the Year) will be awarded an annual membership for the following year along with the Rookie of the Year Trophy.
