# **Ladies Class Program**

Below are detailed guidelines for the Ladies Class

#### **Novice Class Rules**

Beginning with the 2009 season the Alabama region of the SCCA will add a Ladies Class to each event. Below is the guidance for the Ladies Class.

# Eligibility

1. Participants in the Ladies Class (LC) do not have to be members of SCCA. LC participants must be a member of SCCA for cumulative points for year end awards.

### PAX

- 1. All LC participants will awarded raw and PAX times within the group.
- 2. PAX times will determine the winner of each event and be used to accumulate season points..

#### Classes

- 1. LC participants will class their vehicle in accordance (IAW) with SCCA rules.
- 2. Car numbers will be assigned (IAW) ALSCCA practices with the addition of the letter "L" at the beginning of the class. (i.e. LES 14).

# Season Winner

- 1. Season Points will be determined by points awarded throughout the season, following the current guidelines and rules that govern ALSCCA Solo Classes.
- 2. The Ladies Champion will be awarded a class Champion Trophy...
