

Club Class

Beginning with the 2009 season, the ALSSCA will have a Club Class. This is a class so that clubs may attend an event and compete against one another. Clubs may run 2 events per season in the “Club Class.” Cars will be classed IAW SCCA rules. Car numbers will be assigned IAW ALSSCA practices to include a “Z” at the beginning of the class (i.e. ZES 14). If there are more than 1 club participating the letters “Q, K, R” will be used to differentiate the different clubs. A club must have a minimum of 5 entries to utilize the Club Class. Times will be calculated using the PAX calculations. Participants in the Club Class are NOT eligible for event trophies or championship points. If the club so chooses they may distribute awards at the end of the event based on the Official Timing and Scoring results.

Participants in the Club Class will follow the same structure of the Novice Class. (Attend the Novice meeting, Course Walk, Ride along and Instructor Ride along). The only exception to this are those participants that have experience with previous SCCA events. Club Class participants will be required to participate as a course worker as assigned by run groups. Club Class participants will follow all SCCA rules and ALSSCA supplemental rules.

Club Class participants will pay the same entry fee as non SCCA members. (Exception: SCCA member participating in the Club Class will pay the same entry fee as any other SCCA member). Clubs with large participation will receive a contribution from the SCCA to go to the Club’s general fund. Contributions are as follows.
